HAPPY EASTER!

Easter celebrates the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. For Lent, we focused on Jesus' Words from the Cross. But the powerful message of Easter is that those words were not Jesus' final words. Our sermon series titled "In His Own Words" also concludes today, as the season of Lent is over! Before we accept what others say about Jesus, we should consider what Jesus said about himself. The seven "I am" statements of Jesus reveal a different aspect of Jesus' identity. Today we consider Jesus' claim: "I am the resurrection and the life."
