TODAY

Today is **All Saints' Sunday**, an occasion in which we celebrate, with thanksgiving, our Christian unity with the "great cloud of witnesses" (Heb 12:1) Today we remember that all who are united in Christ, whether dead or alive, are saints ("sanctified," make holy, to serve God", because - and only because- of the unmerited work of Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit.

In the wake of addressing an issue of sexual immorality in the Corinthian church, the Apostle Paul gives that church – and us – the "why" behind the instruction to "Flee from sexual immorality" (1 Cor. 6:18). This passage has been called the foundation of Christian sexual ethics because it explains the rationale for the Christian approach to sexual ethics, which is very different from the world's approach to sexual ethics.
